

## Keith Diesel & Dirt Derby 2020 Header Demolition Derby Modification Instructions and Rules

## All headers must have a clearly marked number or name for identification for the commentators and crowd.

- 1. Pickup reel or bat reel removed
- 2. Cutting bar removed
- 3. Crop dividers removed
- 4. Glass removed; from cabs, mirrors, lights etc.
- 5. Weld mesh welded over cab window area for safety
- 6. Must have seatbelt installed and buckled up at all times
- 7. Crash helmet required
- 8. Original fuel tank removed (5 Gal. limit installed in grain tank)
- 9. Rubber tyres only, no fluid or foam in tyres
- 10. Straw choppers removed
- 11. Header height 16-18 inches (fixed solid)
- 12. Unloading Auger to be removed
- 13. Rub bars can be placed around radiator for protection
- 14. Protection around variable speed acceptable
- 15. All chains and belts removed that are not used for forward and reverse motion
- 16. Disabled flag mounted 3 feet above grain tank
- 17. For safety, any number of iron pieces can be used
- 18. Rear axle cannot be narrowed less than straw walkers unless factory option
- 19. All combines need to be inspected and approved before entry by judges
- 20. Hillside combines must be fixed solid
- 21. Combines are only intended to last a 15-minute heat
- 22. All competitors will be breath tested before the event and must be 0% alcohol
- 23. If the header front becomes detached your header will be classed unsafe and you will take no further part in the event
- 24. No concrete in header front / cross auger
